The NT approach to undeserved opposition or oppression

This teaching can sound uncaring to those who are in the midst of suffering. It is not intended to supersede the importance of listening, caring, loving and helping. But at the appropriate stage it can be helpful to those enduring oppression, persecution and other trials.

1. Recognise what is happening

- a. We are sharing in the sufferings of Christ

3. React in love
